SUGGESTED ACCOMMODATION

Below are some suggestions of accommodation with details on how close it is to the venue. Gloucester is not the biggest city and so you can walk from one side of it to the other in 25 minutes. But there are loads of places nearby that are a short bus journey like Cheltenham which also have good options. Below are some we found already.

GLOUCESTER QUAYS:

Really nice part of Gloucester, it has all you need from nice views, outlet shopping, to a wide selection of cafes, bars and restaurants. Staying at the quays means you are approx. 20 min walk to Kings School venue.

Premier Inn – Quayside

Travelodge – Gloucester Quays

<u>City Centre:</u> (these hotels are roughly 10-15 minute walk to the Kins School venue)

Central Hotel Gloucester – Basic hotel right in the centre of town

New County Hotel – Basic hotel right in the centre of town

The New Inn – This is a super old hotel, steeped in history and has many tales of ghosts!

Outside of the centre:

Edward Hotel – more like a B&B run accommodation, easy walking distance to town

Linden Tree – Slightly further out then the quays but a basic old fashioned hotel

Driving Distance outside of the centre:

Holiday Inn Gloucester - Cheltenham - A drive away but has a pool and other extra facilities

Leonardo Hotel Cheltenham – Previously Jurys hotel, this has recently been reopened
